



## **2025 CANADA GAMES**

### **COACH/MANAGER APPLICATION**

#### **Coach/Manager Eligibility and Requirements**

The head coach named on the official registration form must be certified under the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) Competition stream, introduction-advanced context (certified status Club Pro 2 or above) in tennis.

The assistant coach named on the official registration form must be certified under the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) competition stream, introduction context (certified status Club Pro 1 or above) in tennis.

If a Provincial/Territorial team does not distinguish between a head coach and assistant coach, at least one of the team's coaches must be Club Pro 2 tennis certified, while the other must be at least Club Pro 1 certified.

These coaches must be so certified/trained no later than 90 days prior to the opening ceremony (May 11, 2025).

Please note that "NCCP Competition Development Certified, Not Renewed" / "NCCP Competition Development Trained, Not Renewed" / "NCCP Competition Introduction Advanced Certified, Not Renewed" / "NCCP Competition Introduction Certified, Not Renewed" does not qualify under the coaching standards for the 2025 Canada Summer Games.

### **Coach/Manager Selection Process**

The CEO will appoint a committee to invite and review applications and select individuals for both positions.

This committee will also oversee any disciplinary matters, queries, or other inquiries before, during, and after the Canada Games.

### **Coaching Requirement**

Tennis NS can choose 2 Coaches or 1 Coach and 1 Manager.

If a team chooses to bring one coach and one manager, the manager will not be allowed to be on the court during competition.

If female-identifying athletes are being sent, one of the staff must be a woman. If Male-identifying athletes are being sent, and one of the staff members must be a man.

Only those chosen for interviews will be contacted. Those chosen for an interview will be required to present their vision leading up to and including the 2025 Canada Summer Games.
