Provincial Tennis Association Membership:	All participants must hold a valid Provincial Tennis Association membership to register.
Singles Entry Deadline:	Sunday July 6 <sup>th</sup> at midnight. Late entries will not be accepted. For registration assistance, contact Pierre Gallant at <u>pgallant@tenniscanada.com</u> well in advance of the deadline.
Withdrawal Deadline:	The withdrawal deadline to receive full refund is <b>Sunday July 6</b> <sup>th</sup> <b>at midnight.</b>

Rules and Regulations:	The tournament will be conducted under Tennis Canada's ' <u>Rules of the Court 2024</u> ' enforced by the Tournament Directors and Officials.
Failure to complete match/tournament:	In Nova Scotia, players can receive suspension points for a 'Failure to complete match/tournament' code violation.
Default Time Rule:	Players are to report to the tournament desk within 30 minutes of their scheduled match time. Once your match is called, please be prepared as the default time rule will be strictly enforced. Late by :01 to :05 minutes = 1 game forfeit, :06 to :10 minutes = 2 game forfeit, :11 to :15 minutes = 3 game forfeit, and a match default after :15 minutes. Suspension points will be applied to players who fail to appear for a scheduled match (main draw and consolation) without notifying the tournament desk with valid excuse.
Pre & Post Match:	Players must stick to a 5 minute warm up once they go on court. All match participants must report to the tournament desk immediately upon completion of the match to report the score and return the balls. All match results will be reported online upon completion.

Match Formats:	Singles (Except U10):
	Elimination with feed-in consolation through semi-finals
	Best 2 of 3 tiebreaker sets with full 3 <sup>rd</sup> sets.
	U10 Singles:
	Best 2 of 3 short sets to 4 with full 3 <sup>rd</sup> sets, Tiebreaks to 7, to be played at 3-all. Modified formats may apply for small draws.
	Doubles:
	One 8-Game Pro-set, with No-Ads (returner's choice) and a regular tiebreak to 7 at 7-all. No consolation draws for doubles.
Consolation Matches:	Full feed-in to the semi-finals.
	Main draw semi-final loser feed into the consolation semis and could potentially play off for the 3 and 4 <sup>th</sup> positions.
	Scoring format for feed-in consolation, will be best 2 of 3 tiebreaker sets with full 3rd sets (same as main draw).
	There are no consolation matches for doubles.
Seeds:	Seeds will be determined by the National Bank Rankings.
	Under 10 seeding will be based on the Atlantic U10 Point System from current calendar year 4 Star events.
	Draws will have 4 seeds, unless the category has a draw size smaller than 8 participants.

Practice Courts / Warm-Up Court:	Six outdoor courts will be available each morning for practice before the tournament begins. To ensure air access, a priority schedule has been established:

	<ul> <li>Important Notes for All Practice and Warm-Up Courts:</li> <li>Four players can use a practice/warm-up court at one time.</li> <li>Please limit your time on the indoor Court 12 warm-up court to 15 minutes to allow all players an opportunity to warm up.</li> <li>Please note that the availability of Court 12 as a warm-up court may be cancelled if play is forced indoors due to weather conditions.</li> </ul>
