



Club Professional 2 Information Guide

What is the Club Professional 2 Course?

The Club Professional 2 is the third level of Tennis Canada's certification system and is the first course in the pathway to have "High Performance" competencies. (*NCCP Context: Competition Introduction Advanced*).

This course is designed to ensure that Club Professionals continue to develop the skills necessary to be a solid, well-rounded club pro working in all areas of club operation both on and off the court. This course is designed for candidates working as a full time Club Professional, an assistant to the Tennis Director or as a Head Professional at a seasonal facility or community club.

What is the major focus of the Club Professional 2 course?

The Club Professional 2 course focuses on the "Fundamentals" and "Developing" stages of Tennis Canada's Whole Player Development Pathway.

From an "on-court" perspective, the Club Professional 2 course develops the skills and attributes required to manage the training of juniors at a U12 level, both in a recreational and competitive stream. This includes progressive tennis training in red, orange and green courts. This course also focuses on the ability to develop recreational and competitive adults, from a 1.0 NTRP to a 4.5 NTRP in both singles and doubles. The Club Professional 2 course focuses on a widest range of skills, ages and competencies in Tennis Canada's curriculum.

From an "off-court" perspective, the Club Professional 2 course develops the understanding of the business of tennis, including an introduction to the administrative, financial and budgeting skills to plan, market, and deliver a full array of effective on and off court club programming.

What will I learn in this course?

This course will focus of the following "on-court" competencies:

- Demonstration skills
- Coaching through the use of "tactical story telling"
- Systematic and concise feedback
- Creating a high-volume environment
- Training "decision making" skills
- Observational skills training
- Feeding skills
- Doubles session planning
- Introduction to coaching at competition
- Ethical Coaching and Safeguarding

This course will focus of the following "off-court" competencies:

- Image of the pro
- Understanding the club business
- Programming
- Organizing and running events
- Managing programs

- Leadership skills
- Conflict resolution

How will coaches be evaluated in this course?

There are several categories of competencies candidates must complete to achieve Club Professional 2 certification. Below is a list of the evaluations for this course:

Candidates must achieve a “met standard” rating on all of the evaluations to be certified. If candidates achieve an “incomplete” rating on any evaluation(s), they must re-take that evaluation (or in the case of the knowledge evaluation workbook components, complete them).

Candidates have 6 months from the end date of their original course to complete all evaluations; otherwise, they must re-take the entire course at full price.

What are the course prerequisites?

1. Minimum certification requirement of Club Professional 1
2. Must have completed the “CP1” and “Kids’ Tennis” online modules
3. Minimum age of 20 years old
4. Minimum experience of 2 years full time at a year-round facility, or 5 years at a seasonal facility
5. Minimum level of play a 5.0 NTRP (*this will be evaluated during the first grouping of the course*)
6. Possess the playing, demonstration and feeding abilities to work with players up to a 4.5 level.

Note: These competencies will not prevent someone from taking the course; however, they will be a requirement for final certification.

7. Active CPR and Standard First Aid training
8. Be a current member of the Tennis Professionals Association
9. Candidates must sign and complete the CP2 “Commitment to Excellence” form

Who will lead the course?

The course will be led by Tennis Canada Coach Developers who are trained and developed in accordance with the Coaching Association of Canada’s NCCP Learning Facilitator and Evaluator Competency requirements. Our Coach Developers are leading industry experts in the development and management of tennis and recreation facilities, highly regarded coaches and club professionals, sport science experts, educational and curriculum consultants.

How do I register for the course?

The Club Professional 2 course costs \$1,600.00 plus tax. Half of the fee will be due upon acceptance into the course, with the additional half due on the first day of the course.
