

Tennis Nova Scotia Regional Junior Championship - Fact Sheet

Tournament Dates:	<u>Monday July 20th - Sunday July 26th</u>
Categories	<p>July 20-23: BS U12 GS U12 BD U12 GD U12</p> <p>July 23-26 BS U14 GS U14 BD U14 GD U14</p>
Draw Sizes:	Singles draws are limited to 24 entries. Doubles draws are limited to 12 doubles teams and will comprise of the 24 singles players. All entries received by the entry deadline will be considered based on merit, as determined by National Bank Rankings.
Wildcards:	The host club reserves the right to use up to 4 wildcards per singles draw.
Scheduling Exemptions:	In order to maintain a fair and efficient schedule for all participants, we are unable to accommodate individual scheduling requests.
Host Club/Courts:	<p>Sobeys Atlantic Tennis Centre 50 Verdi Dr, Bedford, NS B4A 0C3</p> <p>All matches will be played on the outdoor hard courts. Back up indoor courts may be used in certain situations.</p>
Entry Fees:	<p>\$90 per age group (includes singles and doubles)</p> <p>All registrations and payments must be made online prior to the entry deadline.</p>

<p>Entry Deadline:</p>	<p>4pm, Tuesday July 7th</p> <p>Players will not be entered after this date/time. Having issues registering? Email Molly Pineau at mollypineau@tennisnovascotia.com well in advance of the deadline.</p>
<p>Withdrawal Deadline:</p>	<p>10am, Wednesday July 8th</p> <p>Players have until this date/time to withdraw for a full refund.</p>
<p>Acceptance List:</p>	<p>After the withdrawal deadline tournament organizers will email the acceptance list and alternate list to all players who entered.</p> <p>The acceptance list will be made up of the top 24 players in each singles category (including up to 4 wildcards).</p> <p>The 24 players who qualify for the draw will play singles and doubles.</p> <p>Players who do not gain entry into the tournament will receive a refund of their entry fee.</p>
<p>Draw Formats:</p>	<p>Singles:</p> <p>Round Robin: Players will be grouped in 6 pools of 4 players. Players will play the other three players in their pool. After pool play the winner of each group and two second based players qualify for elimination.</p> <p>The top 6 players (based on ranking) will be seeded 1-6 and be placed in different pools. The #1 seed will be placed in pool A, #2 in pool B, etc.</p> <p>Players 7-12, 13-18, and 19-24 will be randomly placed in different pools.</p> <p>Elimination: The top 8 players from pool play will then compete in an elimination event.</p> <p>Doubles:</p> <p>Elimination: The 12 doubles teams play an elimination event.</p>

<p>Qualification for Singles Elimination Draw:</p>	<p>8 players from pool play qualify for singles elimination. These 8 spots will be automatically given to the 6 pool winners. Pool standings will be determined using the following criteria in this order:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Number of match wins -Head to head -Set % (including super tiebreaks which count as a set) -Game % (excluding super tiebreaks) -Coin flip <p>The other 2 spots will be given to two (of six) second placed players based on the following criteria in this order:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Number of match wins -Set % (including super tiebreaks which count as a set) -Game % (excluding super tiebreaks) -Coin flip
<p>Singles Elimination Draw Seedings:</p>	<p>The winner of pool A will be placed at the top of the draw. The winner of pool B will be placed at the bottom of the draw. The winners of pool C and D will be placed at random in either the #3 or #4 spot in the draw.</p> <p>The winners of pool E and F, and the 2 second placed players will be placed randomly in the 4 remaining spots in the draw.</p>
<p>Match Formats:</p>	<p>All Singles: Best of 3 sets, 10-point super tiebreak for 3rd set.</p> <p>Doubles Matches: 8-Game Pro-set, 7-point tiebreak at 7-all, no-ad.</p> <p>In both singles and doubles matches, alternative match formats or scoring methods may be employed in place of the traditional match format listed below. The modified match formats or scoring methods may involve No-Ad Scoring, Short Sets, or some combination thereof.</p>
<p>Official Ball:</p>	<p>Dunlop Grand Prix - 3 New Balls for Main Draw, Good Used Balls for Consolation.</p>
<p>Racquet Stringing:</p>	<p>Will be available on-site.</p>

Rules and Regulations:	The Tennis Canada ' Rules of the Court 2026 ' will be strictly enforced under the guidance of the Tournament Referee.
Failure to complete match/tournament:	In Nova Scotia, players can receive suspension points for a 'Failure to complete match/tournament' code violation.
